# Swanton Morley Neighbourhood Plan

## **Project Summary**

#### Community Event:

The third community consultation workshop event was held on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2016 presenting the agreed Vision and Objectives that were developed at the previous event and giving local residents the opportunity to comment on the emerging policy statements. Residents were also asked to comment on Breckland Council's 13 Site Allocation Development options identified for Swanton Morley. The event went very well with over one hundred local residents attending. The Vision and Objectives were well received and there was much interest in understanding Breckland's Site Allocations; with a number of lively discussions had around the large map.

### Steering Group (NPSG):

The NPSG met on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2016 following the community workshop event and the focus was on the Breckland Council's Site Allocations consultation in order to help inform Swanton Morley Parish Council.

### Neighbourhood Planning Officer :

Breckland have appointed Jo Wright as their Neighbourhood Planning Officer to provide support to Parish Councils through the neighbourhood planning process.

The NPSG met on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2016. The NPSG discussed at length Breckland's Site Allocations consultation and the views being expressed by local residents.
